



# **ONE BLACK TEACHER**

Black students who have just **ONE BLACK TEACHER** in K-3 are **13% more likely to graduate** from high school and **19% more likely to go to college.** 



## **EDUCATIONAL IMPACT**

Research shows when Black students have Black teachers who reflect their experiences and worldviews, they **perform better in schools**. When they have two Black teachers, they are 32% more likely to go to college.

Black students are also more likely to be placed in gifted education programs if they have a Black teacher, and are less likely to receive suspensions, expulsions, and detentions.
