1.ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- 3.0 GPA
- Bachelors Degree (Can be in progress when you apply)

2. BASIC SKILLS

• Bachelor's Degree in any major from a regionally accredited institution of higher education.

3.SUBJECT MATTER COMPETENCE

- AB-130 Undergraduate Major Option (See advisor for approved majors)
- Subject Matter Program
- · Pass CSET Exam (if applicable)

4. OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPT

 Applicants submit 1 (one) official transcript from each higher education institution attended.

5. CERTIFICATE OF CLEARANCE

TWO STEP PROCESS DUE BY APPLICATION DEADLINE

- 1) Live Scan Fingerprinting (found on TEP website)
- 2) Complete CTC Online Application

6. LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION

- M.Ed. Applicants: Submit Two (2) Academic References and one (1) Professional Reference
- Credential -Only Applicants: Submit one (1) Academic Reference and two (2) Professional References

7. STATEMENT OF PURPOSE & PERSONAL HISTORY STATEMENT ESSAY

COMMISION ON TEACHER CREDENTIALING

Candidates can prepare for the Teacher Education Program by fulfilling the required CTC requirements below. These requirements are not necessary for admission but required to be recommended for credential.

CPR

- Must be completed in person (online not accepted)
- Option 1 Certification is available: American Red Cross, American Heart Association
- Option 2: UCR Extension Course EDUC X351.4

US CONSTITUTION REQUIREMENT

- Option 1 A Baccalaureate degree awarded by a California State University campus
- Option 2 POSC 010, HIST 017A, HISA 110B or an approved community college course that articulates
