If you have, please remember that you cannot transfer more than 105 quarter units from your CCC to UCR.

Coming into UCR, you will ideally have completed (a) Cal-GETC or IGETC and (b) Transfer Admission Guarantee (TAG). The TAG makes transferring easier, and Cal-GETC ensures that all your general education requirements will already have been met.
