

Program Curriculum for Minor in Education Catalog 2018

The Education Minor consists of the satisfactory completion of 24 units in courses identified for the Minor in Education program. Candidates must be in good academic standing and maintain a minimum GPA of at least 2.0 (“C”).

To Petition: Candidates must be declare (petition) minor, a minimum of three (3) quarters, prior to graduating. Letter grades in two education courses*, unique for Minor in Education, are required for petition eligibility. Note: CNAS requires two upper-division education courses. Minor must be approved and posted on your degree progress, prior to initiating/completing the Graduation Application (view [term deadlines](#)).

Course overlap unit restriction: An education course may be used to fulfill either a major or minor program requirement, not both.

At least 16 out of the 24 required units must be from upper-division education courses. The following courses are electives for the Minor in Education.
