

Request for Letter of Intern Eligibility
Academic Year 2018-19

Your request for a letter of eligibility for a UCR University Intern Credential will be reviewed after you have been officially admitted to the UCR Teacher Credential Program. If approved, a letter of eligibility will be issued and will indicate that all pre-service and University Intern Credential requirements have been completed so you will have programmatic support to secure a teaching position while completing your program requirements. Please note that the University Intern Credential is a restricted document and a position must be obtained with a district that has a pre-existing partnership agreement (MOU) with UCR.

Please note that you will be expected to attend your fieldwork (student teaching) assignment as determined by your UCR Supervisor even if you have a letter of intern eligibility. You may continue to interview for employment until the expiration date listed on your letter of intern eligibility. However, during this period you will be expected to meet all attendance requirements at your assigned fieldwork (student teaching) site. **Please note: 30-day substitute and/or long-term substitute teaching does not qualify as an Internship. Please TYPE and sign the form below and return the completed form to Teacher Education in Sproul Hall 1124 by the dates indicated below.**

VERIFICATION OF TEACHING EXPERIENCE (required for all Intern programs): There are **two options** for verification:

- **OPTION 1:** To become eligible for an internship prior to or during your first quarter as a credential candidate you must provide evidence of 120 hours of teaching experience in the form of three letters of recommendation from individuals who have observed you teach. Examples of qualifying experience include, but are not limited to, serving as a substitute teacher or instructional assistant. Experience gained in conjunction with fieldwork hours required by a course does not qualify you for an internship. Use the attached “Letter of Recommendation for Intern Eligibility” form.
- **OPTION 2:** To verify eligibility once enrolled as credential candidate your Supervisor must write a letter of recommendation and the Director must approve your application. Submit completed applications prior to the internship start date (see submission deadlines, above). You are required to complete at least a quarter of student teaching prior to starting an internship.
