The *Athletic Leadership Minor* consists of satisfactory completion of 20 units. Students must be in good academic standing at time of minor declaration.

ALDR Minor Petition Eligibility:

Ideally, by the end of junior year, passing letter grades in two education courses, unique to the Minor in Athletic Leadership, are required. Minor must be approved and posted to your degree prior to submitting any College Graduation Application (view term deadlines <u>here</u>).

- CNAS requires completion of EDUC 050 plus two upper-division EDUC courses to initiate petition process.
- Other Colleges require completion of two EDUC courses (lower and/or upper-division) to initiate petition process.

NOTE: An EDUC course may be used to fulfill either a major or minor program requirement, NOT BOTH.

1. Lower-division requirements (4 units):

• EDUC 050: Intercollegiate Athletics and American Higher Education (4 units)

2. Upper-division requirements (16 units):

- EDUC 147: Education in a Diverse Society (4 units)
- EDUC 150: Policy and Legal Issues in Intercollegiate Athletics (4 units)
- EDUC 152: Education, Hip-Hop, and Sport (4 units)
- EDUC 154: Educational Leadership in a Diverse Society (4 units)
- EDUC 190: Special Studies OR EDUC 198G (Group Internship) or EDUC 198I (Individual Internship)
 - A maximum of 4 units of EDUC 190, or EDUC 198G, or EDUC 198I may be taken to satisfy one of the upper-division EDUC courses above. Course must be approved by the Associate Dean or Chair of Minor Program.
